

How to get to CE Delft



By public transport

A 10-minute walk:

From Delft Central railway station to CE Delft is a 10-minute walk. Walk from the railway station directly to the Oude Delft, turn left and follow the Oude Delft to number 180 (see dots on map).

By tram:

It is also possible to get to CE Delft by tram (take tram, line 1 to Prinsenhof stop).

By car, from the A13 (coming from Rotterdam or The Hague/Amsterdam)

Take the Delft-Noord exit (exit no. 8) to Delft, continue straight on to a T-junction, turn left and continue straight on. At the railway viaduct traffic lights the road bears left and changes name from Wateringsevest to Phoenixstraat, which runs parallel to the viaduct.

Parking

There is no free parking possible in Delft.

To park in the Phoenix garage, follow the Phoenix signs. It is only a few minutes walk to CE Delft (see dots on the map).

Goods

For delivering packages or dropping off passengers, follow the one-way traffic system from Wateringsevest via Noordeinde to Oude Delft (see arrows on the map).
